Funded Programmes

Customised Training Programme

75% funded by Department for Employment and Learning (DEL)

Support is available for accredited training at Level 2 or above to up-skill and re-skill employees to enhance effectiveness in the workplace. A College Advisor will meet with the employer to learn more about the business and discuss the specific training needs required. Training can be provided on College premises or may be delivered on-site at a time and location that best suits the employee.

Innovation Voucher Scheme

Apply for a £4000 Business Innovation Voucher

Small or medium sized business wanting to get that extra edge, or struggling with an issue that needs expert help can apply for an 'Innovation Voucher' worth £4,000. Vouchers can be redeemed at the North West College Business Support Centre.

An Innovation Voucher lets you tap into specialist knowledge to develop forward-thinking solutions or ideas to expand, improve or create new products, services and processes that will help you compete more effectively.

Funded by Invest NI, Innovation Vouchers can be used to 'buy' expertise at the NWRC. Our expert Lecturers and specialist Technical Consultants offer specialist expertise, skills and industry experience and can deliver technical support based on your requirements

What can I use it for?

Innovation means doing things differently to make your business better. Areas covered by an Innovation Voucher include, among others:

- Improving and developing a new product, process or service
- Developing a new business model
- Testing products or services
- Accessing research and scientific expertise
- Efficiency audits and process change

Where there is an available solution on the market, then it is unlikely a voucher will be awarded.

Who can apply?

Small enterprises with fewer than 50 employees and an annual turnover or balance sheet total not exceeding €10 million.

Medium-sized enterprises with between 50 and 249 employees and an annual turnover not exceeding €50m or balance sheet total not exceeding €43m. Companies in this category must not have received assistance through Invest NI's R&D programme in the past five years.

Only companies registered in either Northern Ireland or Republic of Ireland can apply.
